Appraiser's Office Conducting Re-inspections

The Jefferson County Appraiser's Office field personnel are conducting their annual re-inspection of real property, which includes residential, commercial and vacant properties in the City of Oskaloosa. Properties that have new construction and/or a building permit will also be included in the review.

The Jefferson County Appraiser's Office is mandated by K.S.A. 79-1476 to physically re-inspect all real property in Jefferson County at least once every six years. The purpose of this inspection is to verify that the data is current and represents the property accurately. The Appraiser's Office physically inspects approximately 17% of the real property located in Jefferson County each year.

Field staff can identified with Jefferson County photo identification badges and will be driving vehicles that are marked with Jefferson County on the rear of the vehicle.
